ORDER OF THE BOARD (by D. Glosser):

On April 24, 2009, Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE (Ameren) and Goose Creek Power Plant filed a petition asking the Board to review a March 20, 2009 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40.2(a) (2008), 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.302. The Agency issued a renewed Clean Air Act Permit Program (CAAPP) permit, subject to conditions, for the Goose Creek Power Plant facility, an electric generating station owned and operated by Ameren, located at 760 E 2150 N Road in Monticello, Piatt County.

On January 13, 2014, Ameren and Goose Creek Power Plant filed a motion to dismiss (Mot.) this permit appeal. Ameren and Goose Creek Power Plant stated in its motion that the Agency has issued a revised CAAPP permit and, as a result, Ameren and Goose Creek Power Plant “no longer seek to appeal the [Agency’s] CAAPP permit decision at issue in this proceeding.” Mot. at 1. The Board grants Ameren and Goose Creek Power Plant’s motion, dismisses this case, and closes the docket.
