The stench was unreal. The cattle had to be suffering. It was the "tipping point" for me into more vegetarian eating and making sure I know where my animal products are coming from. I have a hard time in restaurants because almost all the fish is farmed (also JAMMED into ponds, eating each other it is assumed out of frustration with their circumstances) and I don't need to ask about the meat and chicken: all of it comes from these factory farms except perhaps in the highest-level, most expensive restaurants. And we don't eat there.
