ORDER OF THE BOARD (by D. Glosser):

On January 24, 2014, the parties timely filed a joint notice to extend the 35-day period within which the Metropolitan Water Reclamation District of Greater Chicago (District) may appeal a December 23, 2013 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2012); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.300(b), 105.206(c), 105.208(a), (c). In the determination, the Agency issued an NPDES permit for the Terrence J. O'Brien Water Reclamation Plant located at 3500 West Howard Street, Skokie, Cook County.

The Board extends the appeal period until March 3, 2014, as the parties request. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2012); 35 III. Adm. Code 105.208(a). If the District fails to file an appeal on or before that date, the Board will dismiss this case and close the docket.
