

JURISDICTION

This Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to the authority vested in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by Section 31.1 of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2010).

FACTS

1. That Gerald Cain is the current property owner and Reynolds Service Co., Inc. is the current operator ("Respondents") of a facility located at the following legal description:

89.92 Acres, Twp. 12S, RNG 2W, SEC 18, Part of SE SW SW NW NW SW, Union County, Illinois. The property is commonly known to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency as Ware/Cain-Reynolds Equipment Co., LLC-Reynolds Service Co. Inc.

- 2. That said facility is designated with Site Code No. 1818645005.
- 3. That Respondents have owned/operated said facility at all times pertinent hereto.
- 4. That on January 3, 2014 Sheila Williams of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's ("Illinois EPA") Marion Regional Office inspected the above-described facility. A copy of the inspection report setting forth the results of said inspection is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

5. That on 2-11-14, Illinois EPA sent this Administrative Citation via Certified Mail No. 7012 0470 0001 2973 9989 - Coir.
7012 0470 0001 2973 9972 - Reynolds
VIOLATIONS

Based upon direct observations made by Sheila Williams during the course of the January 3, 2014 inspection of the above-named facility, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency has determined that Respondents have violated the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (hereinafter, the "Act") as follows:

- (1) That Respondent caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in litter, a violation of Section 21(p)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1) (2010).
- (2) That Respondent caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in open burning, a violation of Section 21(p)(3) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(3) (2010).
- (3) That Respondent caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in deposition of general construction or demolition debris: or clean construction or demolition debris, a violation of Section 21(p)(7) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(7) (2010).

CIVIL PENALTY

Pursuant to Section 42(b)(4-5) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4-5) (2010), Respondents are subject to a civil penalty of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) for each of the violations identified above, for a total of Four Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$4,500.00). If

Respondents elect not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board, the statutory civil penalty specified above shall be due and payable no later than March 18, 2014, unless otherwise provided by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board.

If Respondents elect to contest this Administrative Citation by petitioning the Illinois Pollution Control Board in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2010), and if the Illinois Pollution Control Board issues a finding of violation as alleged herein, after an adjudicatory hearing, Respondents shall be assessed the associated hearing costs incurred by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and the Illinois Pollution Control Board. Those hearing costs shall be assessed in addition to the One Thousand Five Hundred Dollar (\$1,500.00) statutory civil penalty for each violation.

Pursuant to Section 31.1(d)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1(d)(1) (2010), if Respondents fail to petition or elect not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board for review of this Administrative Citation within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service, the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall adopt a final order, which shall include this Administrative Citation and findings of violation as alleged herein, and shall impose the statutory civil penalty specified above.

When payment is made, Respondent's check shall be made payable to the Illinois Environmental Protection Trust Fund and mailed to the attention of Fiscal Services, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Along with payment, Respondents shall complete and return the enclosed Remittance Form to ensure proper documentation of payment.

If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time prescribed by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, interest on said penalty and/or hearing costs shall be assessed against the Respondents from the date payment is due up to and including the date that payment is received. The Office of the Illinois Attorney General may be requested to initiate proceedings against Respondents in Circuit Court to collect said penalty and/or hearing costs, plus any interest accrued.

PROCEDURE FOR CONTESTING THIS
ADMINISTRATIVE CITATION

Respondents have the right to contest this Administrative Citation pursuant to and in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31/1 (2010). If Respondents elect to contest this Administrative Citation, then Respondents shall file a signed Petition for Review, including a Notice of Filing, Certificate of Service, and Notice of Appearance, with the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, State of Illinois Center, 100 West Randolph, Suite 11-500, Chicago, Illinois 60601. A copy of said Petition for Review shall be filed with the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's Division of Legal Counsel at 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Section 31.1 of the Act provides that any Petition for Review shall be filed within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service of this Administrative Citation or the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall enter a default judgment against the Respondents.

GENERAL REMARKS

On January 3, 2014, I conducted an inspection at the Ware/Cain – Reynolds Equipment Company, L.L.C. – Reynolds Service Company, Inc. site. The inspection was conducted as a result of a complaint that waste had been open dumped near Morgan School Road and Clear Creek Levee Road. No one else appeared to be present during the course of the inspection.

Upon arrival, multiple mobile homes, demolition debris, and tires were observed. The waste at the site did not appear to be in use, did not appear to be kept in a way to protect it for future use, and much of it did not appear to be useable in current conditions.

Of the ten mobile homes present, only two of them will not be considered waste at this time. These two are shown in photos 002 and 019. However, if these two are waste, they are to be disposed of properly, too. The remaining eight mobile homes are considered waste because of conditions such as the interiors were exposed to the elements, a mobile home was lying on its side, and dilapidated conditions. Also, the structure shown in photo 014 appeared to be two halves that did not meet, it was apparent insulation was falling into the building from the roof area, and at least one of the windows was open. The mobile homes are estimated to be a total of approximately 1613 cubic yards ([55'x11'x9'] x 8 mobile homes) in size.

Photos 005-010 depict Area A which includes, but is not limited to, demolition wood, wall board, the top portion of a mobile home, insulation, siding, three tires, and a television. Some of the waste was mixed with dirt. It appeared heavy equipment (due to the presence of tracks) had been used to push waste up into a pile. Also, it was apparent open burning had occurred in this area. Smoke was seen wafting from the central portion of waste shown in photo 008 and some of the debris was charred. Area A was estimated to be approximately 300 cubic yards (90'x30'x3') in size.

Area B can be seen in photos 015-016. Among the debris were insulation, wood pallets, demolition debris, and general refuse. Area B was estimated to be approximately 30 cubic yards (20'x20'x2') in size.

Area C was made up of a trailer holding shingles and siding. It appeared at one time a tarp had been used to cover the materials, but the tarp was in poor condition leaving the materials exposed. Area C was estimated to be approximately 14 cubic yards (35'x7'x1.5') in size.

Photo 018 depicts Area D. Among the waste in this area were demolition wood, metal piping, a bathtub, concrete blocks and doors. Area D was estimated to be approximately nine cubic yards (10'x12.5'x2') in size.

The trailer seen in photo 019 appeared to be holding only metal.

Approximately 65 tires were scattered throughout the site. There were approximately 7 cubic yards of tires (67 tires x .1104 cubic yards) present.

A variety of debris was scattered throughout the site. This waste included, but was not limited to, furniture, a dishwasher, a wood platform, a furnace, a refrigerator, a variety of demolition debris, and general refuse.

The vehicle shown in photo 019 displayed the license plate seen in photo 023. This license plate was issued to Reynolds Equipment Company, L.L.C. According to the Illinois Secretary of State's website, the Agent for Reynolds Equipment Company, L.L.C. is Mark S. Johnson out of Cairo, IL and the Principal Office is located at 2875 Route 146 West, Jonesboro, IL.

The license plate on the trailer depicted in photo 024 was issued to Reynolds Service Company Inc. According to the website YellowPagesGoesGreen.org, Reynolds Service Inc. (at 2875 State Route 146 West) is a business that deals with mobile homes. According to the Illinois Secretary of State's website, the Agent for Reynolds Service Company Inc. is Linda Reynolds at 2875 Route 146 West, Jonesboro, IL. The President's name and address is Terry Reynolds at 2875 Route 146 West, Jonesboro, IL.

According to the Union County Assessments Office, Gerald Cain of Anna receives the real estate tax bill for the piece of property on which this site is situated.

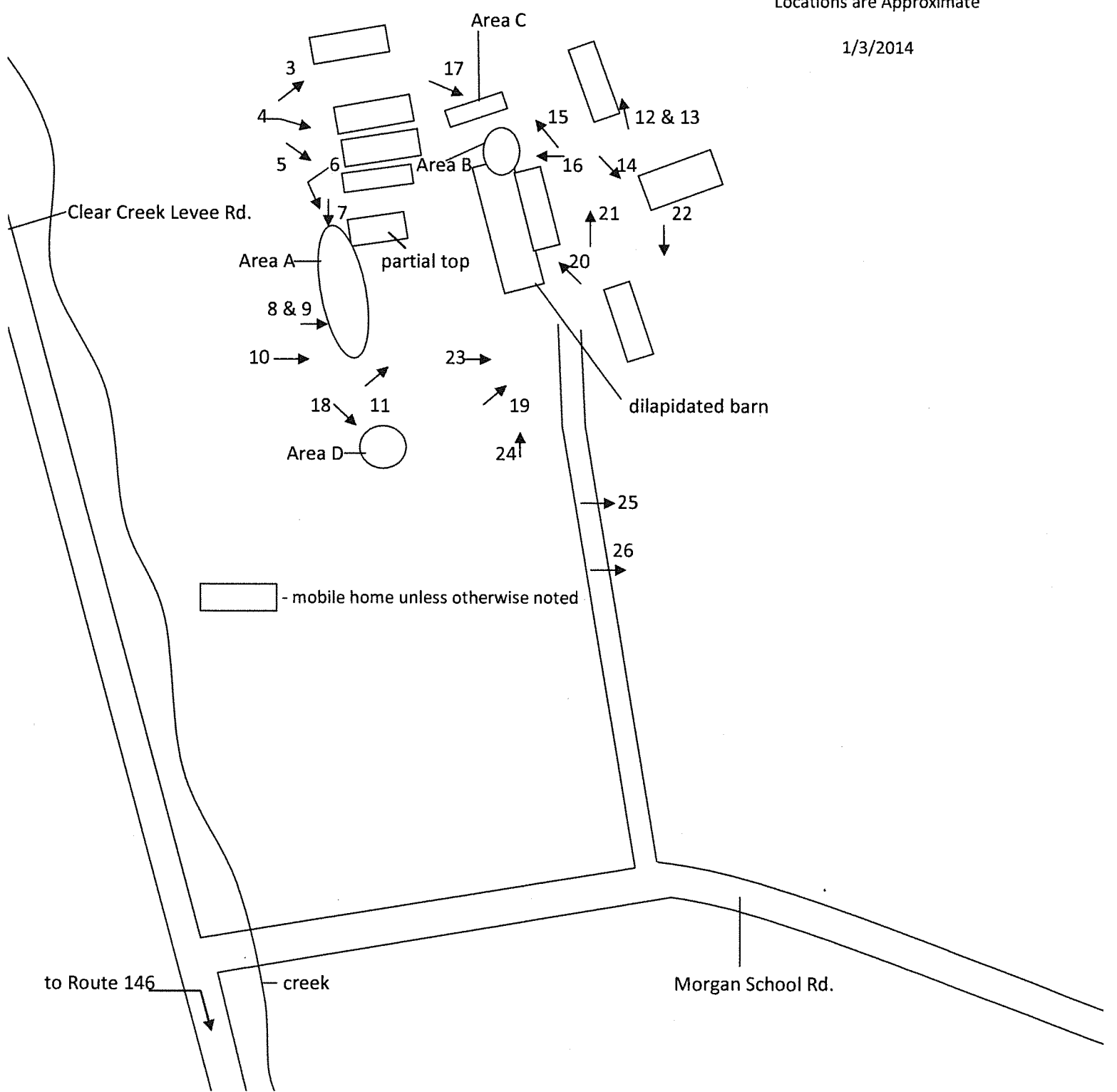
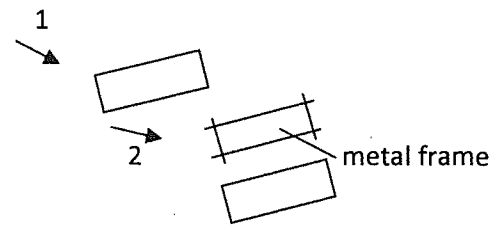


