ORDER OF THE BOARD (by D. Glosser):

On February 21, 2014, the parties timely filed a joint notice to extend the 35-day period within which Greenfield & Greenfield Gold Dust, LLC (petitioner) may appeal a January 14, 2014 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency), which was received by petitioner on January 16, 2014. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2012); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.300(b), 105.206(c), 105.208(a), (c). In the determination, the Agency denied reimbursement for certain costs from the Underground Storage Tank (UST) Fund in regards to a Leaking UST located at petitioner's facility at 600 East Charleston Avenue in Mattoon, Coles County.

The Board extends the appeal period until May 21, 2014, as the parties request. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2012); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.208(a). If petitioner fails to file an appeal on or before that date, the Board will dismiss this case and close the docket.
