ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J.A. Burke):

On March 4, 2014, Unites States Steel Corporation (petitioner) filed a motion to voluntarily dismiss this appeal (Mot.) concerning a Clean Air Act Permit Program (CAAPP) permit issued to petitioner by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency) on September 3, 2009. Petitioner petitioned the Board for review of the CAAPP permit on October 7, 2009. The Board accepted the petition on October 15, 2009, and granted stays of this appeal through February 4, 2014. During this time, petitioner and the Agency resolved the issues relating to this appeal, and the Agency issued petitioner a revised CAAPP permit on March 4, 2013. Mot. at 2. The March 4, 2013 permit is the subject of another proceeding before the Board. *See* United States Steel Corp. v. IEPA, PCB 13-53.

Counsel for the Agency does not object to the motion. Mot. at 2. To date, the Board has not received a response to the motion from American Bottom Conservancy, an intervenor in this proceeding. The Board grants petitioner's motion for voluntary dismissal, dismisses the appeal, and closes the docket.
