ORDER OF THE BOARD (by C.K. Zalewski):

On May 29, 2014, Catherine Thomas, d/b/a Thomas 12th Street Disposal (Thomas) filed four separate motions for voluntary dismissal (Motions) of these consolidated appeals that concern supplemental Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency) waste disposal permits for the closed landfill near Danville, Vermilion County. Thomas had filed petitions for review concerning groundwater monitoring conditions of the permits between April and August 2010. The Board consolidated the cases by order dated November 4, 2010. *See* Catherine Thomas v. Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, PCB 10-52, PCB 10-69, PCB 10-80, PCB 10-85 (Nov. 4, 2010).

In the motions for voluntary dismissal, Thomas states that "[a]ll matters pertaining to the site have been resolved with the issuance of the Certification of Completion of Post-Closure Care dated April 17, 2014, by the Illinois EPA . . . and the release letter of the Letter of Credit dated May 22, 2014." Motions at \P 2. In addition, Thomas states that neither the Agency nor the Attorney General object to the motions. The Board grants Thomas's motions for voluntary dismissal, dismisses the appeals, and closes the dockets.
