## ORDER OF THE BOARD (by D. Glosser):

On May 16, 2014, the parties timely filed a joint notice to extend the 35-day period within which the Premcor Refining Group, Inc. (Premcor) may appeal an April 8, 2014 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). The joint notice was timely filed because it was postmarked on or before the filing deadline. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2012); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.300(b), 105.206(c), 105.208(a), (c). In the determination, the Agency denied Premcor's application for payment from the Underground Storage Tank Fund. Though Premcor's application was dated January 30, 2014, the Agency received the information on February14, 2014, more than a year after the Agency issued its January 31, 2013 No Further Remediation letter for the site in question. The site is known by the Agency as "Decatur/Clark #731," Site Code No. 1150155305, located at 1092 West Grand Avenue in Decatur, Macon County.

The Board extends the appeal period until August 13, 2014, as the parties request. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2012); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.208(a). If Premcor fails to file an appeal on or before that date, the Board will dismiss this case and close the docket.
