ORDER OF THE BOARD (by D. Glosser):

On June 17, 2014, Prairie Rivers Network and Sierra Club (Petitioners) filed a motion to voluntarily dismiss this appeal, which concerns a September 28, 2012 decision of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency to grant a new National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System permit to Peabody Gateway North Mining, L.L.C. The permit allowed for the discharge of pollutants into tributaries of Coulterville Lake and Marys River. Petitioners moved for dismissal after the parties reached a settlement agreement resolving the issues and matters raised in this petition. The Board grants Petitioners' motion for voluntary dismissal, dismisses the appeal, and closes the docket.
