To Whom It May Concern:

I previously filed a request for consideration for a review of my case, which was denied because no new evidence in this case was stated. I respectfully ask that you reconsider your decision based on the information that I am providing.

In the complaint filed by Mr. Kaare Jacobsen, he intentionally omitted information that he submitted to me. Mr. Jacobsen had knowledge and pictures of the person responsible for dumping/littering and burning of the property known to the Agency as Freeport/White Property. Mr. Jacobsen failed to submit a complaint against the person responsible for the violations. According to the complaint it is stated that I had control over the situation and or knowledge of the violations, but with the property being vacant and me living 2 hours away, as I have stated before, I had no control of the situation. The pictures that was submitted to the committee was/is 2 years old, I personally had removed the tires and some of the trash that was on the property at the time of the hearing as I told Ms Ryan in one of our phone conversations.

There is an error stated in the review information that I received, I was not aware of any violations on the property until contacted by Mr. Jacobsen, upon learning of the situation as stated by Mr. Jacobsen, I immediately called the person responsible and told him to clean up the mess he made. Mr Jacobsen had already inspected the property , I did NOT know of the situation 5 months prior to being contacted. I never stated that the violations were not addressed when contacted as stated in the complaint.

After reviewing my information , cannot find that I received notification of the hearing in January or of the review hearing.

In summary there is no evidence that I committed the violations or ordered such. Phillips Petroleum Co.U.IEPA, 72 ILL App, 3<sup>rd</sup> 217,220-21 (2<sup>nd</sup> Dist 1979).
