ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J.A. Burke):

Section 13(c) of the Environmental Protection Act (Act) (415 ILCS 5/13(c) (2012)) requires the Board to adopt regulations that are "identical in substance" to regulations of the United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA). 415 ILCS 5/7.2 (2012). Specifically, Section 13(c) relates to underground injection control (UIC) regulations that USEPA adopted to implement provisions of the Safe Drinking Water Act (42 U.S.C. §§ 300h *et seq.* (2011)). USEPA has codified its UIC regulations at 40 C.F.R. 144 through 148.

The Board reserved this docket for any UIC amendments adopted by USEPA from January 1, 2014 through June 30, 2014. During that time period, USEPA took no action with regard to any provision of 40 C.F.R. 144 through 148. The Board will update incorporations by reference to the *Code of Federal Regulations* and the *United States Code* in 35 Ill. Adm. Code 720.111 in the now-reserved docket <u>RCRA Subtitle C Update</u>, <u>USEPA Amendments (January 1, 2014 through June 30, 2014)</u>, R15-1. Therefore, no action is necessary, and the Board dismisses this docket.
