**HEARING OFFICER ORDER**


On August 12, 2014, the parties filed a joint status report and request for extension of stay (Report). It is noted that on February 20, 2014, the Board granted a stay in the above-captioned matter to and including August 18, 2014. People v. Inverse Investments LLC, PCB 11-79, slip op. at 3 (Feb. 20, 2014).

The parties state that since February 20, 2014, the United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) “has conducted sampling at the Site and at commercial and residential properties in the area.” Report at 2. The parties further state that the USEPA “has also advised that it intends to implement a water main extension project in the City of McHenry in September 2014 near the Site.” *Id.* Due to the ongoing actions by the USEPA at the site, the parties “request that the Board extend the stay for an additional six months, subject to the parties’ right to request an additional extension should the facts and circumstances warrant such a request.” *Id.*

The parties’ request is granted to the extent that this matter is stayed until February 16, 2015. If the parties wish to continue the stay, they must file a status report and request an additional stay at that time.

The parties or their legal representatives are directed to appear at a telephonic status conference with the hearing officer on February 16, 2015, at 9:30 a.m. Please note that the previously scheduled telephonic status conference on September 4, 2014, is cancelled. The telephonic status conference must be initiated by the complainant, but each party is nonetheless responsible for its own appearance. At the conference, the parties must be prepared to discuss the status of the above-captioned matter and their readiness for hearing.


