#### ILLINOIS POLLUTION CONTROL BOARD NOTICE OF PROPOSED

#### STIPULATION AND PROPOSAL FOR SETTLEMENT OF ENFORCEMENT CASE

The Attorney General has brought a case against the Edelstein Waterworks Co-Op, an Illinois not-for-profit corporation for violation of State pollution control rules. On August 12, 2014, the parties filed a stipulation and proposal for settlement. The parties agree that a hearing is unnecessary, and in accordance with State law, have requested that the settlement be adopted without holding a public hearing. Any person desiring that a hearing be held may demand a public hearing in this case by filing a written hearing request with the Illinois Pollution Control Board within 21 days after the publication of this notice. The hearing request should refer to People of the State of Illinois v. Edelstein Waterworks Co-Op, an Illinois not-for-profit corporation, PCB 07-83, and should be mailed to the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, 100 West Randolph Street, Suite 11-500, Chicago, Illinois 60601.
