

**MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE RECOMMENDATION**

NOW COMES the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency ("Illinois EPA"), by one of its attorneys, James M. Kropid, and, pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code Sections 101.522 and 104.416, hereby submits this **Motion for Extension of Time to File Recommendation** to the Petition for an Adjusted Standard ("Petition") filed by the City of Collinsville ("Petitioner"). In support of its Motion, the Illinois EPA states as follows:

1. On August 13, 2014, Petitioner filed its Petition seeking issuance of an Adjusted Standard from portions of 35 Ill. Adm. Code 620.410 for certain constituents.

2. 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.416(a) provides that a recommendation must be filed by the Illinois EPA with the Illinois Pollution Control Board ("Board") within 45 after the filing of the petition or amended petition.

3. The Board has not yet accepted the Petition and has made no finding as to whether the Petition satisfies the content requirements of 35 Ill. Adm. Code 104.406.

4. Because the Board has yet to accept the Petition, the Illinois EPA is uncertain as to whether a recommendation submitted within the required time could or should be based upon the information contained in the Petition that is currently on file.

5. Furthermore, in a telephone call that took place on September 23, 2014, the Petitioner informed the Illinois EPA that it plans to file and/or otherwise provide additional data
