BOARD ADOPTS SECOND NOTICE IN AMENDMENTS TO NOISE REGULATIONS

On June 5, 2003, the Illinois Pollution Control Board adopted a second notice opinion and order in the rulemaking entitled Noise Rule Update: Amendments to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 900 and 903, R03-08. The Board initiated this rulemaking to amend and update the Board's noise rules. The proposed rulemaking now goes to the Joint Committee on Administrative Rules (JCAR) for review.

Specifically, this rulemaking would update definitions and sound measurement procedures contained in 35 Ill. Adm. Code 900 that were adopted in 1973. The basis for these changes is the American National Standards Institute updates from the years 1998-2001. The Board has also proposed the repeal of Part 903 as legislative changes have exempted organized sporting events including motor racing facilities from the Boards noise regulations.

Two hearings were held on this noise rulemaking proposal.
