Board Hearing on Proposed Regulations for Clean Construction or Demolition Debris Fill Operations

The Illinois Pollution Control Board hearing on the rulemaking docketed as In the Matter of: Clean Construction Demolition Debris Fill Operations Under P.A. 94-272 (35 Ill. Adm. Code Part 1100 (R06-19), which was originally scheduled for March 1, 2006 at 10:00 am will instead begin at 2:00pm. The hearing is still being held at the Illinois State Museum Auditorium, 502 South Spring Street, Springfield, Illinois.

The proposed regulations concern clean construction or demolition debris fill operations. The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency proposal adds a new Part 1100 to the Board's regulations.

In accordance with Public Act 94-272, the IEPA proposed the amendments to allow the use of clean construction or demolition debris (CCDD) as fill material in current and former quarries, mines, and other excavations. The public act requires the Board to adopt rules no later than September 1, 2006.
