

Board Proposes Adopts Second-Notice Amendments to Waste Hauling Regulations

On June 7, 2012, the Board proposed amendments to Part 809 of the Board's solid waste and special waste hauling regulations for second-notice review by the Joint Committee on Administrative Rules (JCAR). On October 28, 2011, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (IEPA) filed the proposal, which was docketed as In the Matter of: Proposed Amendments to Nonhazardous Special Waste Hauling and the Uniform Program: (35 Ill. Adm. Code 809), (R12-13).

The proposed amendments are intended to implement Public Act 97-220, which includes provisions amending Sections 21 and 22.2(1) and (1-5) of the Environmental Protection Act to remove Illinois from the Uniform State Hazardous Material Transportation Registration and Permit Program (Uniform Program).

The Board received no public comments on its first-notice proposal. The Board submits its first-notice proposal without substantive amendments to second-notice review by JCAR.
