## Board Adopts Second Notice Proposal to Amend Solid Waste and Special Waste Hauling Regulations

On December 6, 2012, the Pollution Control Board proposed amendments to its solid waste and special waste hauling regulations for second-notice review by the Joint Committee on Administrative Rules (JCAR). The rulemaking is docketed as <u>In the Matter of: Proposed</u> <u>Amendments to Special Waste Hauling Permit Regulations to Implement Public Act 97-1081: 35</u> <u>Ill. Adm. Code 809.204 and 809.212</u> (R13-8).

The proposed amendments sought to implement a provision of Public Act 97-1081 amending Section 22.2(1) of the Environmental Protection Act by extending the duration of special waste hauling permits from one year to three years.
