AGENCY'S MOTION FOR LEAVE TO FILE REPLY TO PETITIONER'S RESPONSE TO AGENCY'S CROSS-MOTION FOR SUMMARY JUDGMENT

Now Comes, Respondent, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, ("Agency"), by and through its attorney, Lisa Madigan, Attorney General of the State of Illinois, and pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code §101.500(e), hereby files the following Motion for Leave to File a Reply to Petitioner's Response to IEPA's Cross Motions for Summary Judgment ("Reply"). In support thereof, the Agency states as follows:

- 1. Section 101.500(e) of the Illinois Pollution Control Board's ("Board's") procedural rules, provides that a person may reply "as permitted by the Board or the hearing officer to prevent material prejudice." 35 Ill. Admin. Code Sec. 101.500(e).
- On September 19, 2014, the Agency filed its Cross-Motion for Summary
 Judgment and Memorandum in Support of its Cross-Motion for Summary Judgment.
- 3. On October 31, 2014, the Petitioner filed a Response to the Agency's Cross Motion for Summary Judgment. In the Response, Petitioner asserts the novel argument that it is

"unsure what conduct is prohibited by the 'continuous' sampling requirement" for dissolved oxygen at the O'Brien Plant. (Pet. Resp. at p. 8).

4. Accordingly, the Agency would be materially prejudiced if it is not permitted by the Board to reply to the claim in the Response that "continuous" monitoring is somehow ambiguous, and requests leave to file a Reply no later than Friday, November 21, 2014.

Wherefore, the Agency, for the above stated reasons, respectfully requests that the Illinois Pollution Control Board enter an Order granting this Motion for Leave to File a Reply to Petitioner's Response, and permitting the Agency leave to file a Reply no later than Friday, November 21, 2014.
