NOW COMES Respondent, ILLINOIS ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY ("IEPA"), by and through the Attorney General of the State of Illinois, *ex rel*. LISA MADIGAN and pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. 2. Section 101.516(a) of the Pollution Control Board ("Board") Procedural Regulations provides, in part, that any "response to a motion for summary judgment must be filed within 14 days after service of the motion for summary judgment." 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.516(a).

3. In addition, Section 101.516(a) of the Board Procedural Regulations allows the hearing officer to "extend the filing and response deadlines contained in this subsection upon

written motion by a party, consistent with any statutory deadlines." 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.516(a).

4. Due to the litigation schedule of counsel for the IEPA, the IEPA seeks an extension of time to file its response to January 9, 2015.
