ORDER OF THE BOARD (by D. Glosser):

On August 7, 2014, at the parties' request, the Board extended until November 5, 2014, the time period for J.D. Strett and Company, Inc. (J.D. Strett) to appeal a July 2, 2014 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2012); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.406. The determination concerns J.D. Strett's underground storage tank (UST) site located at 701 South Park Avenue in Herrin, Williamson County. In its determination, the Agency held that J.D. Strett's application for UST reimbursement was incomplete. Because J.D. Strett failed to timely file an appeal, the Board dismisses this case and closes the docket.
