AC 13-60	IEPA v. James Harris – The Board entered an interim opinion and order finding respondent violated Sections 5/21(p)(1), (p)(3), (p)(4), and (p)(7) of the Act (415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1), (p)(3), (p)(4), (p)(7) (2012)) and assessing a penalty of \$12,000. The Board ordered the Clerk of the Board and the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency to file by January 5, 2015, a statement of hearing costs, supported by affidavit, with service on respondents. Respondent may respond to the cost statements within 21 days of service of those statements.	4-0
AC 14-54	IEPA v. Brian & Tina Page – In response to a joint stipulation and settlement agreement in this administrative citation action involving a Marshall County facility, the Board found that respondents had violated Section 21(p)(1) of the Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1) (2012)) and ordered respondents to pay a civil penalty of \$1,500. The Board also granted the parties' joint motion to dismiss respondents' petition for review. To effectuate the parties' intent that respondent pay a total civil penalty of \$1,500, the Board, on its own motion, dismissed the alleged violation of Section 21(p)(7) of the Act.	4-0
