MCCAMBRIDGE: Let's go on the 2 Let the record show it is now 1:32 p.m. record. 3 This is the hearing in R15-4 in the matter of 4 National Ambient Air Quality Standards US EPA 5 Regulations January 1st, 2014, through June 30th, 6 2014, and November 4th, 2014, and that may change 7 on final adoption. 8 This -- my name is Mike 9 McCambridge. I'm the Hearing Officer. Sitting 10 here in Chicago with me is Board Member Jennifer 11 Burke who is assigned this rulemaking. Could 12 those in Springfield identify themselves? 13 MS. GLOSSER: Chairman Deanna 14 Glosser. 15 MR. MATOESIAN: Charles Matoesian of 16 the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency. 17 MR. MCCAMBRIDGE: Okav. This 18 rulemaking was mandated by Section 10 of the 19 Environmental Protection Act. It requires the 20 Board to maintain rules that are 21 identical-in-substance to the federal national 22 ambient air quality standards. This rulemaking 23 covers the period January 1st through June 30th, 24 2014, with additional later action added as

The Board adopted a proposal for public comment in this on November 20th. notice of proposed amendments appeared in the December 12th issue of the Illinois Register and if I'm not mistaken the public comment period for this will end on January 26th of this month, forty-five days after December 12th. One thing I want to observe for the record is the November -well, let me just describe what US EPA did first. The June 8th, 2014, action was US EPA approval of two new federal equivalent methods for nitrogen oxides, two new federal equivalent methods for ozone and one new federal equivalent method for lead in ambient air and also on June 18th US EPA updated the list of reference and equivalent methods to include those November -- June 18th approvals.

US EPA subsequently on November 4th, 2014, approved one new federal reference method for fine particulates, another federal reference method for coarse particulates and one new federal equivalent method for ozone and one

Page 5 1 new federal equivalent method for carbon monoxide. 2 It may be that the next action I observe will be 3 added to this docket on final adoption. 4 December 18th, 2014, US EPA updated the list of 5 designated reference and equivalent methods to 6 include the four methods that were approved on 7 November 4th, 2014. 8 At this point I think I fully described what US EPA has done and what this is --9 10 the procedural posture of this rulemaking. 11 anyone present -- does anyone present have any 12 questions or comments to submit to the record for 13 this? 14 MR. MATOESIAN: The Agency has none. 15 MR. MCCAMBRIDGE: The Agency has 16 Member Burke? none.
