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AGREED MOTION TO EXTEND THE DISCOVERY SCHEDULE AND MODIFY THE DISCOVERY ORDER

NOW COME the Complainants, Sierra Club, Environmental Law and Policy Center (ELPC), Prairie Rivers Network, and Citizens Against Ruining the Environment (collectively, "Citizens Groups"), by and through counsel, and move the Illinois Pollution Control Board for leave to extend the discovery schedule and modify the discovery order, and in support of their motion state as follows:

- 1. On June 9, 2014, the Hearing Officer for PCB No-2013-015 entered an order establishing the remaining discovery schedule for both Complainants and Respondent. Fact discovery for PCB No-2013-015 was scheduled to end on January 30, 2015.
- 2. On January 14, 2015, Citizens Groups filed their Second Motion for Leave to file Amended Complaint. On January 27, 2015, Midwest Generation, LLC ("MWG") filed a Response to Citizens Groups' Second Motion for Leave to File Amended Complaint. On January 30, 2015, Complainants filed a Motion for Leave to Reply to MWG's Response to Complainants' Section Motion for Leave to File Amended Complaint. In these filings, both

Complainants and Respondent requested different extensions (with different limitations) to the discovery schedule.

- 3. On February 2, 2015, counsel for Citizens Groups and counsel for MWG conferred. Beginning with that discussion and subsequent emails, Counsel agreed to the following:
 - a. A 60-day extension of fact discovery limited to the deposition of Fredrick Veenbaas and written discovery. The subject matter of the extended discovery schedule will encompass all claims and is not limited to the new claims addressed in the proposed Amended Complaint. This subject matter will extend to any matter relevant to the subject matter involved in the pending action;
 - Rescheduling Mr. Veenbaas's deposition to a mutually-agreeable date and location on or before February 20, 2015. Aside from Mr. Veenbaas, Complainants agree to forego any further depositions;
 - c. Authorizing both the Citizens Groups and Respondent to propound 10 additional Interrogatories beyond the limits set by Ill. Sup. Ct. Rule 213(c). These will not be limited in scope to the new claims addressed in the Amended Complaint and will extend to any matter relevant to the subject matter involved in the pending action;
 - d. Authorizing both the Citizens Groups and Respondent to propound 20 additional Requests for Admission beyond the limits set by Ill. Sup. Ct. Rule 216(f). These will not be limited in scope to the new claims addressed in the Amended Complaint and will extend to any matter relevant to the subject matter involved in the pending action;

e. MWG will review redacted material from documents that Citizens Groups have

specified or may specify to assess whether the redactions should be revised based on

the Amended Complaint, at such time as the Board accepts the Amended Complaint

for filing;

f. All written discovery shall be served by March 2 in order to allow adequate time to

respond.

WHEREFORE, Complainants respectfully request that the Board accept the expanded

scope of written discovery and the following agreed proposed revised schedule:

a. Fact discovery shall close on March 31, 2015;

b. Complainants' written expert witness report shall be served on or before May 1,

2015;

c. Respondent's written expert witness report shall be served on or before June 1, 2015;

d. Complainants' written expert witness reply shall be served on or before June 22,

2015;

e. Depositions of expert witnesses shall begin no earlier than July 22, 2015 and be

completed on or before September 22, 2015;

f. Dispositive motions shall be filed on or before November 23, 2015.

PROPOSED HEARING OFFICER ORDER

On February 4, 2015, the parties submitted an Agreed Motion to Extend the Discovery Schedule and Discovery Order. After reviewing the proposed amended discovery schedule and proposed amended scope of discovery, discovery shall be amended as follows:

Order 1: There shall be a 60-day extension of discovery limited to the deposition of Mr. Veenbaas and written discovery. The subject matter of the extended discovery schedule will encompass all claims and is not limited to the new claims addressed in the proposed Amended Complaint. This subject matter will extend to any matter relevant to the subject matter involved in the pending action. The remaining discovery schedule, also attached, is as follows:

Fact discovery shall close on March 31, 2015;

Complainants' written expert witness report shall be served on or before May 1, 2015;

Respondent's written expert witness report shall be served on or before June 1, 2015;

Complainants' written expert witness reply shall be served on or before June 22, 2015;

Depositions of expert witnesses shall begin no earlier than July 22, 2015 and be

completed on or before September 22, 2015;

Dispositive motions shall be filed on or before November 23, 2015.

- **Order 2:** The parties shall reschedule the deposition of Frederick Veenbaas to a mutually-agreeable date and location on or before February 20, 2015. Aside from Mr. Veenbaas, Complainants agree to forego any further depositions.
- **Order 3:** Citizens Groups and Respondent are each authorized to propound 10 additional Interrogatories beyond the limit of 30 Interrogatories set by Ill. Sup. Ct. Rule 213(c). These interrogatories will not be limited in scope to the new claims addressed in the Amended Complaint and will extend to any matter relevant to the subject matter involved in the pending action.
- **Order 4:** Citizens Groups and Respondent are each authorized to propound 20 additional Requests for Admission beyond the limit of 30 Requests for Admission set by Ill. Sup. Ct. Rule 216(f). These will not be limited in scope to the new claims addressed in the Amended Complaint and will extend to any matter relevant to the subject matter involved in the pending action.
- **Order 5:** Midwest Generation will review redacted material from documents that Citizens Groups have specified or may specify to assess whether the redactions should be revised based on the Amended Complaint, at such time as the Board accepts the Amended Complaint for filing;

Order 6: All written discovery shall be served by March 2, 2015 in order to allow adequate time to respond.
