ORDER OF THE BOARD (by D. Glosser):

On November 20, 2014, at the parties' request, the Board extended until February 8, 2015, the time period for Phillips 66 Company (Phillips) to appeal an October 3, 2014 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2012); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.406. The determination concerns Phillips' underground storage tank (UST) site located at 1719 West Madison, Maywood, Cook County. The Agency deducted costs for corrective action at Phillips' UST site. Because Phillips failed to timely file an appeal, the Board dismisses this case and closes the docket.
