AC 12-51	<u>IEPA v. Northern Illinois Service Company</u> – The Board granted respondent's motion to stay the payment of the civil penalty and hearing costs during respondent's pending appeal to the Illinois Appellate Court.	5-0
AC 15-17	<u>IEPA v. Bernard and Carolyn Carr and Jeffrey Yerk</u> – The Board denied respondents' motion to dismiss.	5-0
AC 15-29	IEPA v. Eric Lane, John Rudd, Bob Whitaker, and American Demolition Corporation – The Board found that these Jefferson County respondents violated Sections 21(p)(1), 21(p)(3), and 21(p)(7) of the Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1), (p)(3), and (p)(7) (2012)), and ordered respondents to pay a civil penalty of \$4,500.	5-0
AC 15-31	IEPA v. George William "Bill" Collins – The Board found that this Franklin County respondent violated Sections 21(p)(1), 21(p)(3), and 21(p)(7) of the Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1), (p)(3), and (p)(7) (2012)). Of the three violations of Section 21(p): 1) one is a second or subsequent adjudicated violation of Section 21(p)(1) (IEPA v. Bill Collins, AC 05-09 (Sept. 2, 2004)),subject to a \$3,000 penalty; and 2) the other two—one violation each of Sections 21(p)(3) and 21(p)(7)—are subject to a \$1,500 penalty each as a first violation. The Board therefore ordered respondent to pay a civil penalty of \$6,000.	5-0

AC 15-32	<u>IEPA v. Jamie and Angela Hollon</u> – The Board found that these Hardin County respondents violated Sections $21(p)(1)$, $(p)(7)$, and 55(k)(1) of the Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1), $(p)(7)$, and $55(k)(1)$ (2012)). The two violations of Section 21(p) are each subject to a \$3,000 penalty as second or subsequent adjudicated violations (<u>IEPA v. Jamie & Angela</u> <u>Hollon</u> , AC 15-03 (August 21, 2014)), and the violation of Section $55(k)(1)$ is subject to a \$1,500 penalty as a first violation. The Board therefore ordered respondents to pay a civil penalty of \$7,500	5-0
