#### MOTION FOR EXTENSION

NOW COMES the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency ("Illinois EPA") by Connie L. Tonsor, one of its attorneys, and respectfully moves for an extension of time to file the Illinois EPA's response in the above-encaptioned matter.

- 1) On May 22, 2002, Noveon, Inc. ("Petitioner or Noveon") filed a petition for Adjusted Standard from 35 Ill. Adm. Code 304.122, as it relates to the discharge of ammonia in the effluent from its Henry, Illinois plant. The history of this matter is lengthy and rather complex. Essentially, Noveon has a complex chemical process during which ammonia forms in the waste treatment process. However, nitrification of ammonia in the waste treatment process is inhibited by chemicals used in the production process. Ammonia is not used in the production process.
- 2) On June 20, 2003, the Illinois Pollution Control Board ("Illinois PCB or Board") accepted the petition for hearing.
- Pursuant to Section 104.416 of the Board's procedural regulations, the Illinois EPA's Response to the Petition is due on July 5, 2002. Section 104.416(b) of the Board's rules, 35 Ill. Adm. Code 104.416(b), states that the Response must include an analysis and response to issues raised by the Petitioner regarding the compliance alternatives and the impacts on the receiving stream, 35 Ill. Adm. Code 104.416; 104.406.
- Pursuant to Section 104.416(b), the Illinois EPA initiated a technical review of the information provided in the petition, the costs/benefits of various treatment alternatives and the potential impact on the receiving stream. During this review, which is not yet complete, information developed that will impact the Illinois EPA's response to the petition and necessitate a meeting to discuss technical issues.

- 5) On June 27, 2002, representatives of Noveon met with the Illinois EPA to discuss the pending adjusted standard petition, the possibility of the Illinois EPA's support of the petition and the Illinois EPA's response. At that meeting, the Illinois EPA and Noveon agreed to set a meeting of technical personnel to discuss the technical issues. The Illinois EPA and Noveon are attempting to set a technical staff meeting in July 2002.
- As a result of this meeting, Noveon may file an amended adjusted standard petition and the Illinois EPA's response may change. On July 2, 2002, the parties placed a call to the Hearing Officer indicating their desire to delay the filing of a response until 45 days prior to a hearing date. No hearing date has been set in this matter.
- 7) On June 27, 2002, the Hearing Officer set a status call for July 18, 2002 at 3:00 for this matter. At that time, the Illinois EPA and the Petitioner will further discuss issues pertaining to the Petition.

Wherefore, the Illinois EPA respectfully requests that the Illinois PCB grant its Motion for an Extension of the filing time for the Response until 45 days prior to the hearing set for this matter in order to facilitate a technical meeting between itself and Noveon.
