

NOTICE OF PROPOSED STIPULATION AND PROPOSAL FOR SETTLEMENT OF ENFORCEMENT CASE

The Attorney General has brought a case against the SSW Development, LLC, a dissolved Illinois limited liability corporation, and John Kaup, an individual for violation of State pollution control rules. On May 18, 2015, the parties filed a stipulation and proposal for settlement. The parties agree that a hearing is unnecessary, and in accordance with State law, have requested that the settlement be adopted without holding a public hearing. Any person desiring that a public hearing be held may demand a written hearing request with the Illinois Pollution Control Board within 21 days after the publication of this notice. The hearing request should refer People of the State of Illinois v. SSW Development, LLC, a dissolved Illinois limited liability corporation, and John Kaup, an individual, PCB 15-80 and should be mailed to the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, 100 West Randolph Street, Suite 11-500, Chicago, Illinois 60601.
