### **JURISDICTION**

This Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to authority vested in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by 415 ILCS 5/1 *et. seq.* (2004), specifically 415 ILCS 5/31.1.

### **FACTS**

- 1. The Respondent, Keith A. Kehl, is the present resident, operator, and tax payer of a facility located in the County of Ogle, State of Illinois.
- 2. The facility, located at 11890 Bethel Road, Rochelle, IL, is an open dump, operating without an Illinois Environmental Protection Agency Operating Permit, and designated with the Site Code # 1418320032. The facility is known to the Agency as Kehl, Keith.
- 3. That Respondent, Keith A. Kehl, has occupied, controlled and/or operated the facility at all relevant times hereto.
- 4. That on April 22, 2015 (the inspection upon which this AC was based on) and on August 11 and August 26, 2014 (previous inspections resulting in an Administrative Citation Warning Notice), Paul Cooney, Field Inspector, Ogle County Solid Waste Management Department, inspected the facility.

### **VIOLATIONS**

On the basis of Field Inspector, Paul Cooney's direct observation, he has determined that the Respondent has caused or allowed open dumping and open burning at the above described facility in a manner that has violated the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (hereinafter, the "ACT") as follows:

- 1. The Respondent has caused or allowed littering in violation of 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1).
- 2. The Respondent has caused or allowed open burning in violation of 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(3).
- 3. The Respondent has caused or allowed the deposition of general construction or demolition debris or clean construction or demolition debris in violation of 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(7).

### CIVIL PENALTY

In accordance with 415 ILCS 5/42 (b)(4), the Respondent is subject to a civil penalty of \$1,500.00 for each violation specified above. This is a total of \$4,500.00 for this Citation.

Additionally, should the Respondent elect to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board under the review process described below, after an adjudicatory hearing, the Respondent shall be assessed the hearing costs incurred by the Pollution Control Board. The hearing cost would be in addition to the fine.

If you acknowledge the violations cited herein above, the civil penalty shall be due and payable no later than 35 days from the date of service hereof. If you do not petition the Pollution Control Board for review of the Administrative Citation within 35 days of service of the

Administrative Citation, or contest the Citation, any judgment that may be rendered against you shall specify the due date of the civil fine and any additional costs assessed against you.

When payment is made, checks shall be made payable in equal amounts (\$2250, or 50% of the total penalty each) to:

- (1) Illinois Environmental Protection Trust Fund and mailed to the attention of Fiscal Services, Illinois Protection Agency, 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276.
- (2) Ogle County Solid Waste Fund, Ogle County Treasurer, P.O. Box 40, Oregon, Illinois 61061.

If any civil penalty is not paid within the prescribed time, the law allows for the accumulation and payment of interest on the remaining unpaid balance. If any civil penalty is not paid when due, the Office of the State's Attorney shall be requested to initiate proceedings in Circuit Court to collect the penalty. In addition to the civil penalty, hearing costs, and interest, if any, the Ogle County State's Attorney may seek to recover their costs of litigation.

### PROCEDURE FOR CONTESTING ADMINISTRATIVE CITATION

You have the right to contest this Citation, pursuant to 415 ILCS 5/31.1. If you elect to contest this Citation, you must file a Petition For Review with the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control Board. A copy of the Petition For Review shall be filed with the Ogle County State's Attorney. Your Petition For Review must be filed within 35 days of the date of service of the present citation on you. If you fail to file your Petition, a Default Order against you will entered by the Pollution Control Board.

### General Remarks

The Ogle County Planning and Zoning Department received a complaint about the property regarding the accumulation of landscape waste (logs), piles of wood chips, demolition debris, and open burning of waste. The Ogle County Solid Waste Management Department (OCSWMD) and Zoning Department agreed to go out to the property for a joint inspection.

An Administrative Citation Warning Notice (ACWN) was the result of an inspection on August 11, 2014. The ACWN was issued August 12, 2014. This ACWN resulted from open dumping, the burning of demolition and other types of waste, and the burning of landscape waste which was not generated on the property. Mr. Kehl is in the tree-trimming and removal business. The inspection was completed after the OCSWMD received a citizen complaint about the property.

I arrived at the site at 2:42 PM with Mike Reibel from Ogle County Planning and Zoning. Upon entry into the site there was a large pile of logs and an individual working to split some logs. There were three large piles of mulch, some of which has been there since the last inspection in August 2014 and a pile of firewood. There was a large ash pile within the foundation of an old barn, some scrap metal lying next to the foundation, and a burn barrel. Photos #1-2 plus four zoomed in versions of photos #1-2.

We met with Keith Kehl and discussed the old barn first. Mr. Kehl admitted demolishing the barn and burning the debris from the barn after it had caught fire on April 13, 2015. The local fire department was called to this site to extinguish the fire, which was on the west side of the barn. As a responding member of the Ogle-Lee Fire Protection District, I witnessed the extinguishment of the fire and what was left of the barn after the fire. After this fire, much of the barn remained intact and not impacted by the fire. This barn was approximately 50 feet by 30 feet, and approximately 40 feet high. A picture of the barn is included in Attachment A from an inspection of the property in August 2014. The barn was demolished and the demolition waste burned between April 13, 2015 and April 21, 2015. A garage on the property was also demolished and burned sometime in April, based on statements made by the complainant.

The ash pile which remained from the burning of the demolition debris from the barn was approximately five cubic yards and contained nails and other fasteners from the barn. Also within the foundation of the burned barn there were two tires rims and other waste which

resulted from the open burning of this demolition waste. There were also piles of scrap metal, concrete and other debris scattered around the property as well (an estimated 10 cubic yards). Photos #1-2 zoom view.

I mentioned to Mr. Kehl that burning the demolition waste from the barn was in violation of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (Act) and that the waste should have been disposed of at a permitted landfill.

We also discussed the large pile of logs on site and that these would need to be processed for firewood to be used as fuel for the home, but cannot be burned as a method of disposal since the material was not generated on-site. I also mentioned that the mulch would need to be used for landscaping around the property or land applied according to IEPA regulations. Mr. Kehl stated that the mulch in the piles was drying and that his plan was to use the mulch for trees he intended to plant around his property. Photo #3. The complainant stated that Mr. Kehl frequently hauled in logs, stumps, roots, and branches and some of that is burned for disposal.

Mike Reibel from Ogle County Planning and Zoning discussed some zoning issues regarding running a business from the property, storage of vehicles, the piles of logs visible from the road, and the proper procedures for tearing a structure down and replacing structures.

I left the site at 3:15 PM

### **Alleged Violations**

1. Cause, threaten, or allow air pollution in Illinois (415 ILCS 5/9(a))

The OCSWMD alleges this violation since the demolition debris from the garage and barn were openly burned thereby reducing the debris to a relatively small pile of ash and other debris,

2) Cause or allow open burning of refuse (415 ILCS 5/9(c))

The OCSWMD alleges this violation due to the fact that the Respondent admitted burning the waste created from the demolition of the barn and the visual evidence on-site of open burning, including the ash pile, burned waste inside the foundation, and soot on the foundation. A garage on site was also demolished and burned.

3) Cause or allow open dumping of any waste (415 ILCS 5/21 (a))

The OCSWMD alleges this violation since the Respondent consolidated refuse from the demolished garage and barn and other sources and placed this waste on his property to be burned. In addition, stumps, roots, logs, branches and other woody waste are hauled in from off-site and dumped on the property to accumulate or be burned.

4) Couduct any waste-storage, waste-treatment, or waste-disposal operation (1) without a permit, and (2) in violation of any regulations or standards adopted by the

### Board (415 ILCS 5/21 (d) (1) & (2)).

The OCSWMD alleges this violation due to the dumping and burning of the debris from the garage and barn for disposal, and the other debris from the barn and ash pile from the barn still remaining on-site. The site has no permit from the Agency to conduct such activities.

5) Dispose, treat, store, or abandon any waste, or transport any waste into the state at/to sites not meeting requirements of Act and regulations (415 ILCS 5/21 (e)).

The OCSWMD alleges this violation due to the fact that Respondents' property is being used for waste storage, treatment, and disposal due to the fact that a significant amount of building materials were and other waste were dumped and burned on-site for disposal. The site has no permit from the Agency to conduct such activities.

Cause or allow the open dumping of any waste in a manner which results in any of the following occurrences at the dump site: (1) litter; (3) open burning; and (7) deposition of (i) general construction or demolition debris as defined in Section 3.160 (a) of the Act, and (ii) clean construction or demolition debris as defined in Section 3.160(b) of the Act (415 ILCS 5/21 (p)(1), (3) & (7)).

The OCSWMD alleges these violations due to scrap metal and concrete scattered about the property, the dumping and burning of construction/demolition debris from the garage and barn, the debris inside the foundation which resulted from open burning, and the ash pile on-site. In addition, landscape waste from off-site was being hauled in and dumped and burned.

It was largely contained to the west side of the structure, which, in this photo, is the portion of the barn nearest the vehicle. The April 13<sup>th</sup> fire destroyed the west wall of the barn and the roof over the small overhead door, but advanced no further. Mr. Kehl demolished this structure and burned the debris sometime between April 13, 2015 and April 21, 2015.

Scrap metal not disposed at a landfill can be taken to a scrap metal facility or recycling center. Clean construction and demolition debris may be used as clean fill according to IEPA regulations.
