ORDER OF THE BOARD (by D. Glosser):

On November 3, 2005, Kincaid Generation L.L.C. (Kincaid) timely filed a petition asking the Board to review a September 29, 2005 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency) to issue a Clean Air Act Permit Program (CAAPP) permit with conditions. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40.2(a) (2014); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.302(e). Kincaid challenged the issuance and effective date, as well as numerous conditions including those relating to records and reporting, retroactive compliance, boiler operating and testing, handling and processing, maintenance, and repair protocols. The CAAPP permit application concerns Kincaid's electrical power generating station located four miles west of Kincaid on Route 104, Christian County.

On July 2, 2015, Kincaid filed a motion to voluntarily dismiss this appeal. The Board grants the motion, dismisses the appeal, and closes the docket.
