Notice of Petition by Saline County Landfill, Inc., for an Adjusted Standard Before the Illinois Pollution Control Board

Saline County Landfill, Inc., petitioner, has filed with the Illinois Pollution Control Board a petition for an adjusted standard. The petition was filed July 17, 2015, Board docket no. AS 2016-1. The regulatory standards from which the adjusted standards are sought are:

1. 35 Illinois Administrative Code 811.319 (a), which identifies the "criteria for choosing constituents to be monitored" under a detection monitoring program.

2. 35 Illinois Administrative Code 811.319 (b), and 35 Illinois Administrative Code 811.320, in order to modify the detection and assessment monitoring parameter lists to improve the monitoring program functionality within the strip mine environment.

3. 35 Illinois Administrative Code 811.324, 811.325, and 811.326, in order to implement the use of groundwater protection standards as a trigger for potential corrective action.

The proposed standards are:

1. A modification of the detection and assessment monitoring list of constituents, to better differentiate potential landfill related changes in groundwater quality from the previously degraded strip mine background conditions.

2. Adoption of 35 IL Admin. Code Class I potable ground water and/or general use standards as ground water background standards pursuant to 35 IAC 811.320 (b) for selected constituents (chloride and ammonia), where pre-existing site conditions preclude development of representative site specific background standards.

3. Adoption of 35 IAC 620.410 Class I potable ground water standards for selected constituents as groundwater protection standards in order to determine whether there should be potential need for corrective action within the landfill's zone of at-

Any person may cause a public hearing to be held in the above-described adjusted standard proceeding by filing a hearing request with the Illinois Pollution Control Board within 21 days after the date of the publication of this notice. The hearing request should clearly indicate the docket number for the adjusted standard proceeding, as found in this notice. The hearing request must be mailed to the Clerk of the Board, Illinois Pollution Control Board, 100 W. Randolph Street, Suite 11-500, Chicago, Illinois 60601, or filed electronically through COOL, located on the Board's website (www.ipcb.state.il.us).
