On May 8, 2015, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency) filed a rulemaking proposal to amend Parts 601, 602, and 603 of the Board's rules governing public water supplies (35 Ill. Adm. Code 601, 602, 603). On May 21, 2015, the Board accepted the Agency's proposal for hearing.

The second of two scheduled hearings will be held in Springfield, beginning at 10:00 a.m. on August 17, 2015. The deadline to pre-file testimony for the hearing was July 27, 2015. No pre-filed testimony was filed. However, several public comments were filed. Attached to this order are Board questions for the Agency's witnesses. These questions will be taken up at the second hearing. The hearing officer will, of course, provide opportunities for other participants attending the hearing to pose questions to the Agency.

1. In his public comments, Roger Mensing raises concerns about the requirement in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's (Agency) proposed Section 602.260(a)(14) that a water main construction application specify sewer and water separation. *See* PC 2. Please address the concerns raised in Mr. Mensing's comments.
2. Jeffrey Groncki, in his public comments (PC 3), suggests revisions to the language in the Agency's proposed Sections 601.105, 602.104, and 602.105(a)(3). Please indicate the Agency's position on each of these suggested revisions.
3. In public comments filed July 28, 2015, Captain Michael Curry poses questions and comments on, and proposes revisions to, the Agency's proposed language in a number of sections of Parts 601 and 602. PC 4. Please address Capt. Curry's comments, questions, and proposed revisions, as applicable, with respect to proposed Sections 601.105, 602.106, 602.107(a), 602.109, 602.113(c), 602.117, 602.119, 602.200, 602.205(b), 602.210(h), 602.225, 602.235, 602.245, 602.250, 602.255, 602.260, 602.305, 602.310, 602.405, 602.410 and 602.505.
