On August 1, 2014, F.A. Stein Oil Co. (petitioner) timely filed a petition asking the Board to review a July 11, 2014 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2014); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.300(b), 105.402, 105.404, 105.406. The Agency's determination concerns Stein Oil's leaking underground storage tank (UST) site located at 2004 South Belt West in Belleville, St. Clair County. On August 6, 2015, the petitioner filed a motion to dismiss the petition. The Board grants petitioner's motion for voluntary dismissal, dismisses the appeal, and closes the docket.
