

ORDER OF THE BOARD (by D. Glosser):

On November 21, 2014, P & M Service Center (petitioner) timely filed a petition asking the Board to review an October 17, 2014 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2014); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.300(b), 105.402, 105.404, 105.406. The Agency's determination concerns petitioner's leaking underground storage tank (UST) site located at 233 East Jackson Street in Macomb, McDonough County. On August 6, 2015, the petitioner filed a motion to dismiss the petition. The Board grants petitioner's motion for voluntary dismissal, dismisses the appeal, and closes the docket.
