

ORDER OF THE BOARD (by C. K. Zalewski):

On May 1, 2015, Barnhill's Service Station (petitioner) timely filed a petition asking the Board to review a March 25, 2015 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2014); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.300(b), 105.402, 105.404, 105.406. The Agency's determination concerns petitioner's leaking underground storage tank (UST) site formerly located at 17976 State Highway 37 in Karnak, Pulaski County. On August 6, 2015, the petitioner filed a motion to dismiss the petition. The Board grants petitioner's motion for voluntary dismissal, dismisses the appeal, and closes the docket.
