ORDER OF THE BOARD (by D. Glosser):

On May 13, 2015, the parties timely filed a joint notice to extend the 35-day period within which the petitioners may appeal an April 2, 2015 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2014); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.300(b), 105.206(c), 105.208(a), (c). In the determination, the Agency denied reimbursement of corrective action at petitioner's service station located at 1218 Peoria Street, Washington, Tazewell County. On May 21, 2015, the Board extended the appeal period until August 10, 2015. On August 6, 2015, the petitioner filed a motion to dismiss the petition. The Board grants petitioner's motion for voluntary dismissal, dismisses the appeal, and closes the docket.
