NOTICE OF PROPOSED STIPULATION AND PROPOSAL FOR SETTLEMENT OF ENFORCEMENT CASE

The Attorney General has brought a case against the Village of Percy for violation of State pollution control rules. On August 19, 2015, the parties filed a stipulation and proposal for settlement.
