ORDER OF THE BOARD (by D. Glosser):

On May 19, 2008, Pilkington North America, Inc. (Pilkington) timely filed a petition asking the Board to review an April 10, 2008 permit determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency) to issue a Clean Air Act Permit Program (CAAPP) permit with conditions. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40.2(a) (2014); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.302(e). Pilkington challenged the issuance of the revised CAAPP permit on the grounds that the permit contains numerous errors, rendering it inconsistent with the federal Clean Air Act, the Act, and the respective underlying regulations The CAAPP permit application concerns Pilkington's flat glass manufacturing facility located at Center and 20th Street, P.O. Box 578, Ottawa, LaSalle County.

On December 3, 2015, Pilkington filed a motion to voluntarily dismiss this appeal. The Board grants the motion, dismisses the appeal, and closes the docket.
