ORDER OF THE BOARD (by G.M. Keenan):

On January 26, 2015, NACME Steel Processing, L.L.C. petitioned the Board for review of a Federally Enforceable State Operating Permit issued by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency for NACME's steel pickling facility at 429 West 127th Street in Chicago. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40.2(a) (2014); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.302(e). In NACME's permit, the Agency required compliance with federal performance standards for metal coil surface coating operations, found at 40 C.F.R. Part 60, Subpart TT.

On December 16, 2015, NACME moved to dismiss its permit appeal because the Agency issued a revised permit that did not require compliance with Subpart TT. The revised permit comes into effect when the Board grants NACME's motion to dismiss its appeal. This order does so: the Board grants NACME's motion, dismisses the case, and closes the docket.
