ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J.D. O’Leary):


On October 30, 2014, Ameren Missouri and Raccoon Creek Energy Center (collectively, petitioners) timely filed a petition asking the Board to review a September 25, 2014 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40.2(a) (2014); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.300(b), 105.302(e). The Agency issued a Clean Air Act Permit Program (CAAPP) permit with conditions to petitioners’ electric generating station located at 676 Cypress Drive, Flora, Clay County.

On January 22, 2016, petitioners filed a motion for voluntary dismissal (Mot.), which states that the parties have resolved the issues raised in this appeal and that the Agency has issued a revised permit. Mot. at 1. Petitioners request that the Board dismiss this matter and state that the Agency does not object. *Id.*

The Board grants petitioners’ motion, dismisses the appeal, and closes the docket.
