NOW COMES Respondent, ILLINOIS ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY, by Lisa Madigan, Attorney General of the State of Illinois, and in reply to the responses of Petitioner, UNITED STATES STEEL CORPORATION, to the Illinois Pollution Control Board's ("Board") requests for additional information, states as follows:

- 1.
