
ORDER OF THE BOARD (by C.K. Zalewski):

On January 7, 2015, Ameren Missouri and Pinckneyville Energy Center (Ameren) filed a petition asking the Board to review a December 23, 2014 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (IEPA). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2006); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.206(a). That December 23, 2014 determination is a Clean Air Act Permit Program permit renewal for Ameren’s electric generation station located at 4646 White Walnut Road, Pinckneyville, Perry County.

On February 8, 2016, Ameren filed a motion to dismiss this permit appeal (Mot.). In its motion, Ameren states that, “Petitioners and Respondent resolved the issues related to this appeal, and Respondent [h]as issued a revised permit.” Mot. at 3. Ameren requests that “the Board dismiss this matter and close the docket.” *Id.* Ameren finally states that IEPA does not object to the motion. Therefore, Board grants Ameren’s motion, dismisses this case, and closes the docket.
