
HEARING OFFICER ORDER

On April 28, 2016, all parties participated in a telephonic status conference with the hearing officer. The parties were informed that the Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) motion to reschedule the hearing scheduled for May 10, 2016, was granted to the extent that the hearing record will open on May 10, 2016, but will be immediately continued on record to May 23, 2016. The parties represented that all witnesses will be available for the rescheduled hearing date. My written order will be issued on May 2, 2016.

IDOT stated that it will revise its response to JM's Request to Admit Number 11 by May 2, 2016. IDOT also stated that it will file its response to JM's motion to strike affirmative defenses, filed April 20, 2016, on or before May 4, 2016. JM stated that it will disclose its expert disclosure report on May 3, 2016. Deposition scheduled for May 9, 2016. Discovery closes on May 9, 2016, but may be revisited at the next status conference.

The parties or their legal representatives are directed to appear at a telephonic status conference with the hearing officer on May 5, 2016, at 1:30 p.m. The telephonic conference must be initiated by the complainant, but each party is nonetheless responsible for its own appearance. At the conference, the parties must be prepared to discuss the status of the above-captioned matter and their readiness for hearing.


