**BOARD NOTICE OF PROPOSED STIPULATION  
AND PROPOSAL FOR SETTLEMENT  
OF ENFORCEMENT CASE**

The Attorney General has brought a case against the Crop Production Services, a Delaware corporation for violation of State pollution control rules. The alleged violations occurred at three agricultural and fertilizer retail facilities: one in Sinclair, Morgan County; another in White Hall, Greene County; and a third southwest of Galesburg and east of Highway 41 in Knox County. On April 6, 2016, the parties filed a stipulation and proposal for settlement. The parties agree that a hearing is unnecessary, and in accordance with State law, have requested that the settlement be adopted without holding a public hearing. Any person desiring that a hearing be held may demand a public hearing in this case by filing a written hearing request with the Illinois Pollution Control Board within 21 days after the publication of this notice. The hearing request should refer People of the State of Illinois v. Crop Production Services, a Delaware corporation, PCB 09-60 and should be mailed to the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, 100 West Randolph Street, Suite 11-500, Chicago, Illinois 60601.
