ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J. A. Burke):

Ogle County alleges that Wayne L. and Christina C. Fisher committed open dumping violations at 102 Oak Street in Holcomb, Ogle County. The County refers to the property as the Fisher, Wayne L. & Christina C. site, IEPA-LPC Site #1418215008. The Board directs the Fishers to file an amended petition.

The County served the administrative citation on the Fishers within 60 days after the date of the observed violation. *See* 415 ILCS 5/31.1(b) (2014); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.300(c), 108.202(b). On June 3, 2016, within 35 days of service, the Board received a single page document stating that Wayne and Christina Fisher seek to appeal the administrative citation along with their reasons for doing so. *See* 415 ILCS 5/31.1(d) (2014); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.300(b), 108.204(b). The bottom of the document is signed by Wayne Fisher but not Christina Fisher. Additional markings appear below Wayne Fisher's signature. The document is a photocopy and information may have been omitted during photocopying.

Therefore, the Board orders Wayne and Christina Fisher to file an amended petition. If the document contains additional information below Wayne Fisher's signature, respondents must file a complete version of the document. The Board notes that the petition must be signed by both Wayne Fisher and Christina Fisher.

The Fishers must mail a copy of the amended petition to the County and file proof with the Board that the petition was mailed to the County. *See* 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.304.

If no amended petition is filed with the Board by August 8, 2016, which is the first business day following the 30th day after the date of this order, the case will proceed with Wayne Fisher only and a default judgment will be entered against Christina Fisher. *See* IEPA v. Ray Logsdon Estate, *et al.*, AC 05-54 (Apr. 21, 2005).
