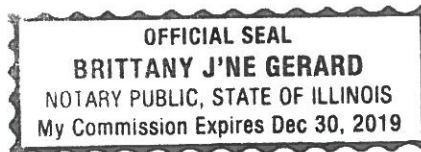
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On Monday, August 8, 2016, Calpine Operating Services Company, Inc. ("Calpine") filed with the Illinois Pollution Control Board ("Board"), a Petition for Variance under Section 35 of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act ("Act"). Variances may be granted pursuant to Section 35 of the Act (415 ILCS 5/35) and 35 Ill. Adm. Code Part 104.

Calpine requests a variance to extend the January 1, 2017 compliance deadline at its Zion Energy Center for use of distillate fuel oil containing 15 ppm or less sulfur in the Zion Energy Center's combustion sources, pursuant to 35 Ill. Admin. Code 214.161(b). Calpine requests a five-year variance for Zion Energy. Zion Energy Center is located at 5701 West Ninth Street, Zion, IL 60099.

Any person may request a public hearing in the above-described proceeding by filing a written objection and request for hearing with the Illinois Pollution Control Board within 21 days after the date of the publication of this notice.
