RECOMMENDATION OF THE ILLINOIS ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY

The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency ("Illinois EPA") hereby files its Recommendation pursuant to Section 125.204 of the regulations of the Illinois Pollution Control Board ("Board"), 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.204.

- On December 14, 2015, the Illinois EPA received a request from, LLC-New Boston (log number TC-33-15, Exhibit A) for an Illinois EPA recommendation regarding the tax certification of water pollution control facilities pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.204.
- 2. The facility's address is:

 MSF Farms, LLC-New Boston
 524 107th Ave
 New Boston, IL 61272

The proposed water pollution control facilities in this request are located in the SW ¼ of Section 5, T14N, R5W of the 4th P.M. in Mercer County, at the above street address and consist of the following:

Livestock waste handling facilities consisting of two (2) concrete manure pits (approximately 390 ft. x 50 ft. x 8 ft. each) and the concrete slat portion of the floor over the manure pits that capture and contain waste generated in the barn above. Each pit has ten (10) (approximately 6 ft. x 5 ft. x 8 ft. each) pump out pits to allow manure removal from the manure pit.

These livestock waste management facilities are used to collect, transport and/or store livestock waste prior to cropland application, and are further described in Exhibit A.

 Section 11-10 of the Property Tax Code, 35 ILCS 200/11-10 (2014), and Section 125.200(a) of the Board's regulations, 35 III. Adm. Code 125.200(a), define "pollution control facilities" as:

any system, method, construction, device or appliance appurtenant thereto or any portion of any building or equipment, that is designed, constructed, installed or operated for the primary purpose of: eliminating, preventing, or reducing air or water pollution ...or treating, pretreating, modifying or disposing of any potential solid, liquid or gaseous pollutant which if released without treatment, pretreatment modification or disposal might be harmful, detrimental or offensive to human, plant or animal life, or to property.

- In order to receive preferential tax treatment as pursuant to 35 ILCS 200/11-5
 (2014), pollution control facilities must be certified as such by the Board, 35
 ILCS 200/11-20 (2014) and 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.200(a).
- Upon receipt of a tax certification application, the Illinois EPA must file a recommendation on the application with the Board, 35 Ill Adm. Code 125.204(a).
- Based on the information in the application and the purpose of the facility, it is the Illinois EPA's engineering judgment that the described facilities may be considered "pollution control facilities," pursuant to 35 III. Adm. Code 125.200(a), with the primary purpose of eliminating, preventing, or reducing water pollution, or as otherwise provided in 35 III. Adm. Code 125.200, and are eligible for tax certification from the Board.

WHEREFORE, the Illinois EPA recommends that the Board issue the requested tax certification.

The Bureau of Water received a request on December 14, 2015 from Matt Frieden for an Illinois EPA recommendation regarding the tax certification of water pollution control facilities pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.204. We offer the following recommendation.

The water pollution control facilities in this request include the following:

MSF Farms, LLC 524 107th Ave New Boston, IL

SW 1/4 of Section 5, T14N, R5W of the 4th PM in Mercer County.

The livestock waste handling facilities consist of two (2) concrete manure pits (approximately 390 ft. x 50 ft. x 8 ft. each) and the concrete slat portion of the floor over the manure pits that capture and contain waste generated in the barn above. Each pit has ten (10) (approximately 6 ft. x 5 ft. x 8 ft. each) pumpout pits to allow manure removal from the manure pit. These facilities collect, transport and store livestock waste prior to cropland application.

The facility is further described in the enclosed applications and supporting documents.

Based on the information included in this submittal, it is our engineering judgment that the above proposed facilities may be considered "Pollution Control Facilities" under 35 IAC 125.200(a), with the primary purpose of eliminating, preventing, or reducing water pollution, or as otherwise provided in this section, and therefore eligible for tax certification from the Illinois Pollution Control Board. The Bureau of Water therefore recommends that the Board issue the requested tax certification for these facilities.


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



The producer will receive the benefit of the reduced assessment for the first year the IDOR assumes jurisdiction, but it will not be reflected in the producers tax bill until the following year. All tax bills in Illinois are actually issued the year following the assessment date. For example, a tax bill will not be issued until approximately May 2001 for all property assessed as of January 1, 2000.

INSTRUCTIONS

Although the tax certification application form was originally designed for industrial use, the Agency uses it for all pollution control facilities. The following instructions indicate how to complete the application form when tax certification is being sought for livestock waste management facilities.

Section A - Applicant:

Be sure to provide the property tax identification number for the parcel of land where pollution control facilities are located. Also indicate the location of the pollution control facilities by quarter section, township, range and county. This information is available on county plat maps.

Section B - Manufacturing Operations:

Indicate what type of livestock waste the pollution control facilities control. Most livestock facilities in Illinois do not have or need any permits from the Illinois EPA and, therefore, the permits space can usually be left blank.

Section C - Manufacturing Process:

This section does not need to be completed on applications for livestock waste management facilities.

Section D - Poliution Control Facility:

The following information must be provided. Use additional paper when necessary.

Neatly sketch a diagram showing the flow of livestock waste from the animals through the pollution control facilities to final disposal on cropland. Include the locations of components such as pumps, pipes, gutter scrapers, manure pits, tanks, slotted floors, holding ponds for runoff, lagoons, methane digesters, settling basins, vegetative filters, etc.

Briefly describe the major pollution control components on the flow diagram including dimensions (length, width, depth, diameter), construction materials (steel, concrete block, etc.), and size (i.e., 10 H-P centrifugal pump).

Identify local streams, lakes, groundwater, or other waters that the pollution control facilities protect from contamination by livestock wastes. Briefly explain how the pollution control facilities prevent livestock wastes from entering these waters.

Section E - Pollution Control Facility Contaminants and Accounting Data:

Generally identify the pollutants being controlled (i.e., beef feedlot runoff, swine manure, silage leachate, etc.) and points of discharge if there are any. Items 3, 4 and 5 must be completed. Be sure to sign in Section F.
