## ILLINOIS POLLUTION CONTROL

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The Illinois Pollution Control Board gives notice of public hearings regarding rule changes proposed by the Board on September 8, 2016: In The Matter of: Permit by Rule for Boilers: Amendments to 35 III. Adm. Code Parts 201 and 211, R17-9. If adopted by the Board, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) intends to submit the adopted rule to the United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) for approval as State Implementation Plan (SIP) revisions. The proposed rules would allow construction of small boilers under a "permit by rule": a general permit obviating the need for Illinois EPA to individually grant construction permits for these types of boilers. Illinois EPA also proposed general provisions for permits by rule. (Though the Illinois Environmental Protection Act authorizes the Board to adopt general provisions for permits by rule (415 ILCS 5/39,12(b) (2014)), no such provisions currently exist.) If adopted, the general permit by rule provisions would apply to future proposed permits by rule for other types of emission units. Interested persons are invited to attend the hearings and to submit written comments. The Public Hearings will be held on October 26, 2016 AND November 16, 2016, at 1:00 pm at the lames R. Thompson Center, 100 West Randolph, Chicago Illinois, in Room 2-025, and in the Illinois Pollution Control Board Conference Room, 1021 North Grand Avenue East, North Entrance, Room 1244N, Springfield, Illinois by video conference. The hearings are subject to cancellation without notice and may be confirmed by calling the Office of the Clerk at 312/814-3461.
