JURISDICTION

This Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to authority vested in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by 415 ILCS 5/1 et. seq., specifically 415 ILCS 5/31.1.

FACTS

- 1. The Respondent, Richard Mansfield, is the present owner, occupant and in control and possession of a facility located in the County of Jackson, State of Illinois.
- 2. The facility is an open dump, operating without an Illinois Environmental Protection Agency Operating Permit, and designated with the Site Code # 077 804 5030. The facility is known to the Agency as the Dowell/Richard Mansfield site.
- The Respondent has owned, occupied, controlled and/or operated the facility at all material times hereto.
- 4. On September 19, 2016, Don Terry, Field Inspector, Jackson County Health Department, inspected the facility. A true and correct copy of the inspection report, along with Mr. Terry's affidavit, are attached and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit A.

VIOLATIONS

On the basis of Field Inspector Don Terry's direct observation he has determined that the Respondent has caused or allowed open dumping at the above described facility in a manner that resulted in the following violations:

That on September 19, 2016, an inspection of the facility disclosed the following:

- 1. The Respondent has caused or allowed litter at the facility in violation of 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1).
- 2. The Respondent has caused or allowed the proliferation of disease vectors at the facility in violation of 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(5).
- 3. The Respondent has caused or allowed the deposition of general or clean construction or demolition debris at the facility in violation of 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(7).

CIVIL PENALTY

Pursuant to Section 42(b)(4-5) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4-5), Respondent is subject to a civil penalty of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) for each of the violations identified above, for a total of <u>FOUR THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$4,500.00)</u>. If Respondent elects not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board, the statutory civil penalty specified above shall be due and payable no later than November 15, 2016, unless otherwise provided by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board.

If Respondent elects to contest this Administrative Citation by petitioning the Illinois Pollution Control Board in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1, and if the Illinois Pollution Control Board issues a finding of violation as alleged herein, after an adjudicatory hearing, Respondent shall be assessed the associated hearing costs incurred by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and the Illinois Pollution Control Board. Those

hearing costs shall be assessed in addition to the Fifteen Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) statutory civil penalty for each violation.

Pursuant to Section 31.1(d)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1(d)(1), if Respondent fails to petition or elect not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board for review of this Administrative Citation within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service, the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall adopt a final order, which shall include this Administrative Citation and findings of violation as alleged herein, and shall impose the statutory civil penalty specified above.

When payment is made, checks shall be made payable in equal amounts (50% of total penalty each) to:

- County of Jackson, c/o Jackson County Treasurer, Jackson County Courthouse,
 Murphsyboro, Illinois 62966; and
- (2) Illinois Environmental Protection Trust Fund and mailed to the attention of Fiscal Services, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276.

Respondent shall complete and return the enclosed Remittance Forms with payments to ensure proper documentation of payment. If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time prescribed by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, interest on said penalty and/or hearing costs shall be assessed against the Respondent from the date payment is due up to and including the date that payment is received. The Complainant may either initiate proceedings against the Respondent in Circuit Court or other debt collection actions to collect said penalty and/or hearing costs, plus any interest accrued.

PROCEDURE FOR CONTESTING ADMINISTRATIVE CITATION

You have the right to contest this Citation, pursuant to 415 ILCS 5/31.1. If you elect to contest this Citation, you must file a Petition For Review with the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control Board. A copy of the Petition For Review shall also be filed with Daniel Brenner, Assistant State's Attorney, Jackson County Courthouse, Third Floor, Murphysboro, Il 62966. YOUR PETITION FOR REVIEW MUST BE FILED WITHIN 35 DAYS OF THE DATE OF SERVICE OF THE PRESENT CITATION ON YOU. YOUR PETITION MUST STATE THE REASON(S) YOU BELIEVE THE PRESENT MATTER SHOULD NOT BE ISSUED. IF YOU FAIL TO FILE YOUR PETITION AND STATE THE REASONS THE PRESENT MATER SHOULD NOT BE ISSUED, A DEFAULT ORDER AGAINST YOU WILL BE ENTERED BY THE POLLUTION CONTROL BOARD.

GENERAL REMARKS

NOTE: As of September 26, 2016 the Jackson County Assessor's Office shows that this site is owned by Richard Mansfield [Attachment: Page 1].

During the stated date and time, I conducted an inspection of the site listed above. This inspection was made as a follow up to an inspection conducted on July 20, 2016 during which open dumped waste was observed scattered around the site. Weather conditions at the time of the inspection were: Sunny with calm winds and a temperature of approximately 73°F. I was accompanied on this inspection by Kyle Scerena of the Jackson County Health Department (JCHD).

Upon arrival at the site, I observed from Lincoln Street Extension, a public roadway, a waste pop-up camping trailer overgrown with vegetation (Photo #1, Site Sketch – A). I observed this waste camping trailer during my previous inspection of the site. It appears to be in the same general location as it was during my previous inspection and today it is much more overgrown with vegetation indicating that it is not in use and is not being protected for future use.

I then walked west along the driveway and from one location looked north and observed material lying on the ground west of a mobile home (Photo #2, Site Sketch – B). I walked north towards the material and observed several piles open dumped waste (Photos #3 - #5, Site Sketch – B & C). The waste in these two areas (B & C) consisted of but was not limited to: plywood, PVC pipe, dimensional lumber and two tub/shower enclosures. One of the tub/shower enclosures was holding water (Photos #5 & #6, Site Sketch – B). Kyle Scerena who was accompanying me, is a sanitarian at the JCHD. Some of his duties include working in the vector control program; specifically catching and identifying mosquitoes. I kicked the tub/shower enclosure and asked Mr. Scerena if he saw any mosquito larvae or pupa. Mr. Scerena pointed out two or three areas where there were mosquito larvae and pupa moving. I looked carefully and observed them in the water. I took a photo towards one of the areas where I observed movement (Photo #6, Site Sketch – B). Upon return to the JCHD, Mr. Scerena and I looked at Photo #6 and when it was magnified he pointed out two mosquito pupa in the photo (Photo #6, Site Sketch – B; see two black circles in upper center of photo).

I walked to the northwest and observed a waste pile consisting of, but not limited to: dimensional lumber, metal framed windows, PVC pipe and a used/waste tire (Photo #7, Site Sketch - D). The items in this waste pile were not in use and not being protected for future use.

South of the waste pile labeled "D" on the Site Sketch, I observed two burn piles which I had observed during previous inspections (Photos #8 & #9, Site Sketch – BP1 & BP2). The waste in these two piles consisted of but was not limited to: ash, dimensional lumber, melted upholstery fabric and vinyl siding. I did not observe evidence that the open burning of waste had recently occurred at this site.

South of the burn piles I observed a waste vehicle that appeared to have been in an accident (Photos #10 & #11, Site Sketch – E).

West of the demolished vehicle I observed more open dumped waste (Photos #12 - #15, Site Sketch – F & G). The waste in these area consisted of but was not limited to: metal wire, dimensional lumber, metal cans, plastic containers, metal poles, a metal animal watering tank (the tank was holding water but no evidence of mosquitos was observed), roofing shingles, car parts and a waste boat.

South of the waste vehicle I observed another waste pile (Photos #16 - #18, Site Sketch - H). The waste in this area consisted of but was not limited to: scrap metal, metal wire, a television, a metal propane tank, plastic items, a waste metal trailer and dimensional lumber.

At the time of the inspection, the materials listed as waste in the narrative were not in use, were not useable in their current condition, and were not stored in such a way as to protect any future use.

The total volume of waste observed was approximately 100 + cubic yards.

My inspection ended at approximately 10:04 a.m.

Violations Observed:

Item #5(21)(a): Cause or allow open dumping; Item #8(21)(p)(1, 5 & 7): Cause or allow the open dumping of any waste in a manner which results in any of the following occurrences at the dump site: (1) Litter, (5) Proliferation of disease vectors (7) Deposition of general construction or demolition debris; or clean construction or demolition debris: During the inspection, the open dumping of waste that resulted in litter, the proliferation of disease vectors and the deposition of general construction or demolition debris was observed.

Item #9(55)(a)(1): No person shall: Cause or allow open dumping of any used or waste tire: At the time of the inspection, one used/waste tire that had been open dumped was observed.


