6	received post-hearing comments from the Agency on
7	November 7, 2016. The Board received no pre-filed
8	testimony for this hearing.

                  First, I would like to address the matter

     of the Economic Impact Study. Section 27(b) of the
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Page 10 1 Environmental Protection Act requires the Board to 2 request that the Department, now known as the 3 Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity, DCEO, 4 conduct an Economic Impact Study of proposed rules 5 before the Board adopts them. The Board then must make 6 either the Economic Impact Study or the Department's 7 explanation for not conducting one available to the 8 public at least 20 days before a public hearing. 9 In a letter dated October 24, 2016, the 10 Board's Chairman, Jerry Keenan, requested that the Department conduct an Economic Impact Study of the 11 12 proposed rule. The Board specifically requested a 13 response no later than Tuesday, November 15, 2016. The 14 Board has not received a response to this letter. 15 Would anyone like to testify regarding the 16 request from the Board to DCEO? 17 (No response.) 18 MR. JAMES: Nobody here in Chicago. And I don't 19 see anybody in Springfield. So that's nobody, so we'll 20 go ahead and move on. 2.1 Next, I would like to address the matter 22 of the State Implementation Plan revision. 23 Illinois EPA intends to submit the final rules produced 24 in this rule-making to the United States Environment

1	Protection Agency as a revision to Illinois' State
2	Implementation Plan under the federal Clean Air Act.
3	Illinois EPA also intends to submit an
4	anti-backsliding demonstration to USEPA, as required by
5	the Clean Air Act.
6	Federal regulations require public notice
7	and the opportunity for hearing before submitting SIP
8	revisions to USEPA. The rules, when adopted, must be
9	submitted to USEPA for approval and incorporation to
10	the Illinois SIP because they are intended to ensure
11	that the boilers and other emissions units that could
12	prospectively be covered under a permit-by-rule do not
13	interfere with attainment or maintenance of the
14	National Ambient Air Quality Standards promulgated by
15	USEPA.
16	Would anyone like to testify regarding the
17	proposed revisions to the Illinois SIP or the
18	associated anti-backsliding demonstration?
19	(No response.)
20	MR. JAMES: I don't see anybody here in Chicago.
21	And I don't see anybody in Springfield.
